

THE BONDWOMAN'S NARRATIVE

An unprecedented historical and literary event, *The Bondwoman's Narrative*, written in the 1850s, is the only know novel by a female African American slave, and quite possibly the first novel written by a black woman anywhere. Attributed to pseudonymous author Hannah Crafts, the novel leaves clues that lead researchers to believe that the work was penned by Hannah Bond, who escaped from slavery in North Carolina in 1857 and settled in New Jersey. The novel recounts the experiences of a young mixed-race slave who escapes to the North and finds freedom.
